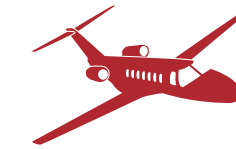

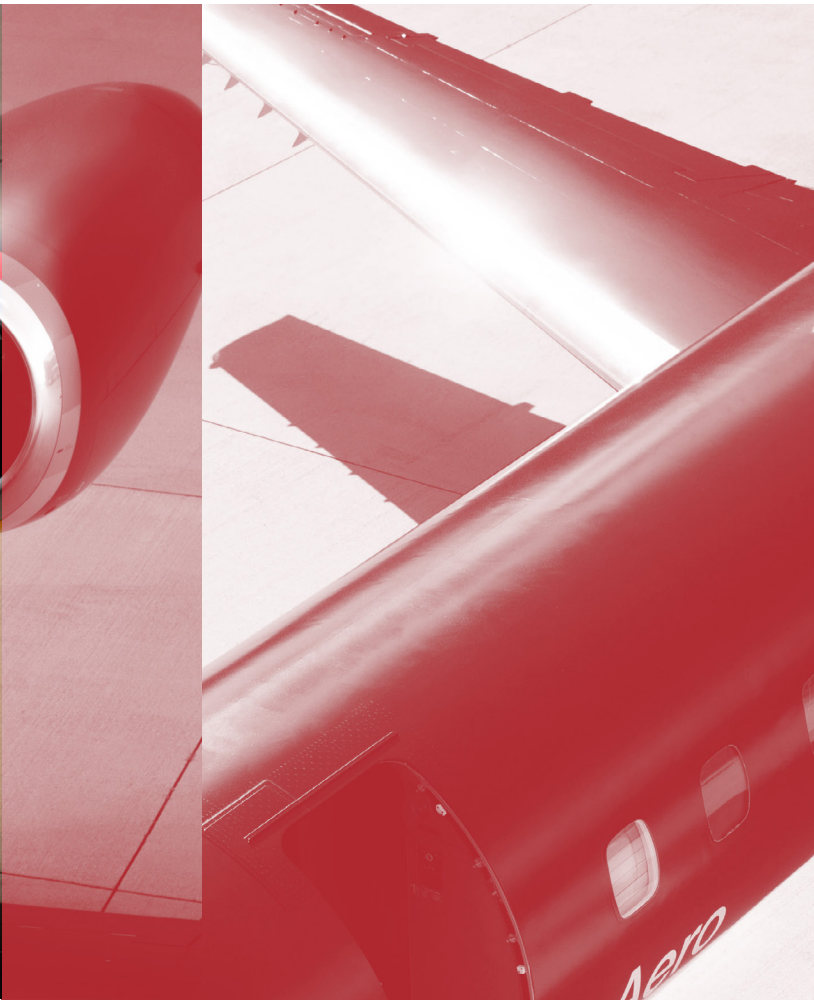

Engineered for high speed and peak performance, the twin-engine aircraft is the height of luxury, featuring custom Italian leather seats with maximum headroom and a 43-inch pitch, plus mood lighting and a state-of-the-art Bongiobi Acousti Labs sound system. Each leg of the trip (except the short hop from Dubrovnik to Venice) will be an enriching experience in its own right, thanks to on-board dining designed exclusively for Red Savannah by the esteemed chefs of London's Mosimann's dining club. And with each flight clocking in under three hours, you may even wish our time in the air could last longer. On the ground, private terminals* and expedited boarding and customs will further ensure the smoothest journey possible, from start to finish.

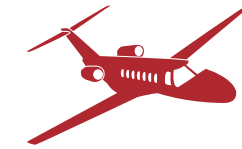
Gastronomy Above It All

Our Grand Tour begins in London, a city rich with history, royal majesty, and world-class restaurants, hotels, and museums. There won't be a moment to waste—with just one night in town before we are whisked away on the first leg of our journey, there will be much to see. Not to worry: Your accommodations at the lavish Corinthia will put you in the beating heart of London, on the edge of the River Thames and a mere stone's throw from great sites like the Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, Buckingham Palace, and Trafalgar Square. Corinthia London

The Corinthia welcomes you to Europe’s most cosmopolitan city with drama and opulence. Originally the home of the Ministry of Defence, the grand landmark between the River Thames and Trafalgar Square is now one of London’s most prestigious hotels, designed by Irish architect David Collins with brilliant gold leaf panels and sparkling crystal chandeliers. While the South Bank, West End, and other major sites are all within walking distance, there will be just as much to do upon checking in to your Junior Suite: cure your jetlag with a treatment at the 35,000-square-foot EspaLife spa, dine on fresh Mediterranean cuisine in the Garden, or sip cocktails with views of bustling Whitehall Place at Michelin-starred Chef Tom Kerridge’s Bar and Grill.

Palermo

13-16 SEPTEMBER 2023

From London, we board our private jet for Sicily, the storied Mediterranean island just off the tip of Italy's boot. Over the centuries, the capital of Palermo has been claimed by the Roman and Byzantine empires, the Greeks and the Normans, and the Arabs and the Moors—and today, this long and varied history plays out in the city's myriad architectural landmarks and distinctly diverse culture. Our Grand Tour uncovers Sicily's many treasures and famed delicacies over three exhilarating days. Zip from Capo to Vucciria on a Vespa to sample the island's superb seafood, organic olive oils, and celebrated wines; take a tour of the Royal Palace and Palatine Chapel with an expert, the seat of the kings of Sicily for centuries; or explore Palermo's historic streets by vintage Fiat 500. Our group comes together for more local discoveries, including a private cocktail reception at the 11th century Cupola del Santissimo Salvatore and an exclusive evening at Palazzo Francavilla, where owners Antonino and Liliana Pecororo will host a majestic dinner amid 19th-century frescoes.

Villa Igiea, A Rocco Forte Hotel

Sicily's most storied private villa has played host to Edward VII, Archduke Franz Ferdinand, the King of Siam—and now you. An Art Nouveau masterpiece designed in 1900 for one of Sicily's great aristocratic families, the estate has been reimagined by Rocco Forte Hotels as Palermo's most exquisite place to stay, with elegant rooms lined in heritage Sicilian tiles and a fine dining restaurant run by Italian chef Fulvio Pierangelini. Take a leisurely breakfast—organic free-range eggs and rosemary focaccine perhaps—on your Junior Suite's private terrace, then relax on a green-and-white striped lounge at the swimming pool or on the private beach overlooking the Tyrrhenian Sea.

Santorini

16-19 SEPTEMBER 2023

Our private jet soars east, over the cerulean Ionian waters, to arrive at our next destination: the stunning Cyclades, where the whitewashed villages of Santorini cling to dramatic cliffs high above the Aegean Sea. Amid photogenic blue domes and rugged rock formations, we'll spend three enchanting days exploring this volcanic island, diving deep into its culture, nature, and culinary treasures via cooking classes, wine tastings, and visits to great archeological sites. Choose from a pottery workshop in Oia, a hike to the rim of the 70,000-year-old Santorini caldera, or a journey to the well-preserved medieval village of Pyrgos, known as "the Greek Pompeii." We'll also commune with locals at authentic tavernas, cruise via speedboat to lesser-known islands like Ios and Sikinos, and dance the night away on a romantic terrace overlooking the piercing turquoise sea.

Named the best resort in Greece by Travel + Leisure readers, the Grace Santorini claims an enviable position on the caldera's edge in central Imerovigli. The minimalist suites are a quintessential expression of the Greek Isles, with sleek all-white interiors and expansive terraces overlooking the sea. The restaurant's Mediterranean haute cuisine is by Lefteris Lazarou, Greece's first Michelin-starred chef and the gastronomic genius behind Athens's lauded Varoulko. The fresh seafood dishes are exquisite and the Greek olive oil massages at the spa are pure bliss, but nothing—and we mean nothing—will compare to the sunset views from your private plunge pool.

Dubrovnik

19-22 SEPTEMBER 2023

Our Grand Tour takes us next to the Pearl of the Adriatic, where unique history, cultural heritage, and unrivaled natural beauty come together at the edge of the sea. The walled Old Town, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, is one of the best-preserved medieval cities in the world, having protected its people from wars, epidemic, and invasions for nearly a millennium. But in this uniquely diverse destination, you're just as likely to encounter jaw-dropping islands and hinterlands as you are to discover incredible Renaissance and Gothic architecture. On our three-day exploration of the city and its surroundings, you'll have the opportunity to experience it all: fresh oyster picnics and winery tours, kayaking or game fishing in the Adriatic Sea, local-led tours of the Old Town's Baroque masterpieces, and exhibitions at the acclaimed Sebastian Gallery. As a group, we'll also spend a relaxing day at Bowa restaurant and beach club on Sipan island, as well as enjoy a VIP dinner at Nautika restaurant, a beautifully restored former maritime school that Michelin calls "the place to be seen in the city."

You'll feel like you have the Adriatic Sea all to yourself at this cliffside contemporary retreat just 10 minutes from the Old Town. Upon checking into your sea-view room, you'll be hard-pressed to think of a better way to spend an afternoon than on your balcony—or sunbathing on the hotel's seaside platforms lined with chic white loungers. The vistas continue at the al fresco Giardino restaurant, the clubby Prosciutto & Wine Bar, and even at the Villa Spa, where post-treatment, you can soak in the indoor pool overlooking Lokrum Island.

Venice

The Grand Tour culminates in one of Europe's most beloved destinations: the enduringly magical, breathtakingly beautiful, floating city of Venice. Simply put, there is nowhere else in the world like it — and our journey ends with a visit you'll never forget, whether it's your first time or your 50th time in La Serenissima. Perhaps nowhere is the cultural fabric of a city more feverishly preserved and respected than in Venice, and our guests will have a chance to soak it all in, from historic *squeros* where artisans have been crafting handmade gondolas for centuries, to legendary palazzos and secret gardens where we'll enjoy private, behind-the-scenes tours. You'll also have the opportunity to visit the ateliers of a traditional mask maker and Carnival costumer; join VIP group experiences like a private cocktail party at Seguso, hosted by the preeminent Murano glassmaker's 32nd-generation owners. Cipriani, A Belmond Hotel

La dolce vita is alive and well at the Cipriani, the legendary hotel of Giuseppe Cipriani, inventor of the Bellini and founder of Harry's Bar. Though the Guidecca hotel is blissfully removed from the crowds of the main island, it's arguably the most elegant address in all of Venice, dripping with Murano glassware and framed by exquisite gardens. The hubbub of the city is never far away—and the Cipriani will whisk you to St. Mark's Square in just a few minutes via its vintage wooden boat—but it's just as likely you'll choose to keep an eye on the scene from across the lagoon, lying by the Olympic-size swimming pool, dining at the Michelin-starred Oro, or relaxing on the balcony of your Junior Suite.
